

District Human Development Committee (DHDC) Gadchiroli invites EoI
for providing support to its Projects in two Talukas of District
PRAKALP DHANANKUR

The District of Gadchiroli was at the bottom of Human Development Index (0.21) at the national level during the last report. Health, Education and Employment Generation activities are the targeted areas to improve the HDI of the district. With the purpose of extending the access and reach of Healthcare/ Education in the rural areas of this District, the undersigned wants to take the help of Private Organizations/ NGOs/ SHGs for the programmes listed below. **Dhanora (Area 1950.33 SqKm) and Kurkheda (Area 1495.97 SqKm) Talukas** of Gadchiroli District, which are amongst the lowest in Development Index in the District, have been taken as **Pilot talukas under the District Human Development Committee (DHDC)** for these projects.

Expression of Interest is invited from bidders who would like to work with the District Administration for one or more of the following programmes:

(i) Running Multipurpose Vehicles as Ambulances

20 Ambulances would be required in these talukas to cover the remotest villages with 20 minutes/ 3 km while being deployed at the most frequented positions of the Tehsils. The focus will be to tackle the IMR and MMR figures in the remotest parts of the Talukas.

The Vehicles should be in very good condition and registration and make of/ or later than the year 2005 and will have life saving medicines and stretcher. The Driver of the Ambulance would be trained in Basic Health care by the District Health department.

The vehicles would receive remuneration @ Rs 15000 per month, all inclusive (Driver, maintenance, POL etc) for a distance travelled of 1500 km per month. To ensure development and income generation of the local Self Help Groups (SHGs), **preference would be given to vehicles placed by the local SHGs.**

Application Fees: *The application fee for this Project for the interested bidders is Rs 1500/-*

(ii) 24X7 Health Advisory through Medical Call Centre

The Toll Free Call centre will be running 24 hours a day in three shifts. Two operators preferably paramedics would man it each shift requiring a total of 6 personnel. The call centre would also serve the purpose of monitoring the Ambulance network through GIS enabled systems and their deployment in cases like emergency deliveries to promote institutional deliveries.

This will also administer information flow from the regular health programmes and School Health Programmes with focus on monitoring the initiatives on Adolescent Girls Health and School Retention, Neonatal Health Care Programmes and Maternal Benefit Schemes with individualized attention.

The EoI should include the annual cost of running the call centre with cost components on man power, AC, LAN network and Telephone wiring, 3 Computer Terminals, GPS Trackers, Servers, Routers, Training and costs of GIS application, viewer, and work station. The physical space for the call centre will be provided by District Administration.

Application Fees: *The application fee for this Project for the interested bidders is Rs 5000/-*

(iii) Healthcare Experts for Health camps/ Mobile Health Services

The following Medical Officers, Medical Staff and other staff will be provided by the NGOs for each of the two selected Talukas:

1. A Medical Officer/ Physician (MD) * with ECG Machine
2. A Gynecologist (MD/ DGO)* with USG Machine (Subject to compliance of all legal provisions)
3. A Pediatrician (MD/ DCH)*
4. 1 nursing staff
5. 1 Driver

(*) In case some of the Specialists listed above are not available, the agency/NGO should state how they plan to bridge the gap. In evaluation higher weightage would be given to MD/ MS as compared to the Diploma posts, wherever available

The medical staff will be visiting the Gram Panchayats (GPs), which do not have the RH/ PHC/ PHU, on a vehicle provided by the DHDC. They will cover jointly 2 GPs in the morning and 2 GPs in the post lunch session on pre-planned date and time and duly advertised locally. This will provide medical access to the interior parts of the District atleast once every week.

A Mobile Pathology Unit (MPU) run by the District Administration will accompany the experts for required checks and Tests. On the proposal of the specialists, if required, the patients would be transferred by the local Ambulance network to the Rural Hospitals.

Application Fees: *The application fee for this Project for the interested bidders is Rs 6000/-*

(iv) Mobile Pathological Unit (MPU)

Two MPUs will be required for the two talukas which will have all the accessories, chemical analyzer for all routine investigations, Complete Blood Count (CBC), HB%, ESR, KFT, LFT, Pulse oxymeter with atleast three parameters (BP, O2 and ECG), portable X Ray, Electrophoresis, Generator/ Inverter, medicines and charges for maintenance/ POL.

The vehicles will have Computer and video recording facility for building Health Record and will carry out Blood Group and Blood Sugar tests, Hemoglobin for Anaemia, Sickle Cell Confirmatory Tests, Urine and Stool Examination.

The following Medical Officers, Medical Staff and other staff will be deployed on each of the vehicles:

1. Pathologist **
2. Laboratory technician */ Other (X Ray) Technician **
3. Driver
4. Support Staff

(**)- As (*) in above

Prospective Users to be covered in the pre approved checkups will include the local Aanganwadi children (approx.17000), Local School children and all the residents of that locality who might like to avail the services at the rates pre-approved by the District Health Committee. The focus would be Anemia status of Adolescent Girl Child, Malnutrition status of ICDS and Primary School Going Children and Health Programmes for expecting mothers.

Interested bidder should provide two rates for this opportunity as per the two models below-

Model 1:

Government Provides the Mobile Pathological Unit (MPU) with all the accessories, the Interested Agencies / NGO will provide the medical staff for running the two MPUs

Model 2:

The Interested Agency will provide the Medical Unit (MPU) with all the accessories, medical equipments, medicines and maintenance/ POL as listed above along with the trained Medical Practitioners and support staff for the two MPUs.

Application Fees: The application fee for this Project for the interested bidders is Rs 6000/-

(v) Mobile Dental Unit (MDU)

Two MDUs will be required for the two talukas and will have all the accessories like two modern Dental Chairs, Anesthesia facility and capacity of all routine dental investigations, it will also have portable Ultrasonic Machine for scanning, Generator/ Inverter, and provide medicines and maintenance/ POL for vehicles. They will visit once every GP of the Taluka or as per the Treatment requirements.

Instrument/ equipment required for MDU

1. Air Conditioned Mobile Van constructed for dental clinic with wash basin, waste water storage tank and seating arrangement for patient.
2. Dental Chair with up/down movement, push button for backrest adjustment from upright to complete flat position.
3. Dental air compressor
4. Dental RVG Sensor with compatible Pentium IV – Computer
5. Refrigerator for Medicine
6. Generator/ Inverter/ Emergency Power Back up

There will be a Programme Manager and following Medical Officers and Staff will be deployed on each vehicles:

1. Dentist*
2. Dental technician *
3. Dental Hygienist
4. Computer Operator*
5. Driver

The treatments of the citizens will be his will be done charged to them at the pre approved rates of the District Health Committee.

Model 1:

Government Provides the Mobile Dental Unit (MDU) with all the accessories, The Interested Agencies/ NGO will provide the medical staff for running the MDUs, two units as stated above- for the Talukas of Dhanora and Kurkheda.

Model 2:

The Interested Agency will provide the Medical Unit (MDU) with all the accessories, medical equipments, medicines and maintenance/ POL as listed above along with the trained Medical Practitioners and support staff for the two MDUs.

Application Fees: The application fee for this Project for the interested bidders is Rs 6000/-

(vi) Oral Health Campaign

There is high incidence of Oral Health problems in the District. Hence, all villages of the Two Talukas would be checked for Dental Health including Oral Cancer.

The interested bidders would submit plan for each Taluka separately with 8 Dentists and Four Helpers working simultaneously at four locations. The programme is expected to run for 6 months in a Taluka.

Vehicles will be provided by District Administration for Gram Panchayat wise Campaign covering the Anganwadi Centres, Schools and then other people.

Computerized Data Base should be prepared as an outcome of this exercise for focused attention on the identified patients and future monitoring.

Application Fees: The application fee for this Project for the interested bidders is Rs 3000/-

(vii) Education Services through ICT support

Interested organizations that have the requisite experience of providing Distance Learning through VSAT are required to submit their Technical and Financial Proposal of setting up the education structure- including the hardware and applications required for the same.

The organizations will provide education with the help of IT through the **Common IT Infrastructure** at School. The same Common IT Infrastructure would be used by the bidder for providing other Educational Services on payment basis. The IT setup would be used for the education in the following manner-

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All instruments like Computers, UPS, Cameras, Projectors, Servers, Routers, Antennae, and consumables would be provided by the interested bidders. *The proposal should include the number of Students to Computers to be provided by them for the success of envisaged plan.* The interested bidder will have to provide the training material in Marathi and one of the local languages in the two Talukas.

The interested bidder will also have to provide a plan as to how the continuity of training will be ensured in the areas with shortage in Electricity supply. It is recommended that the support staff deployment for running of Training Programmes is ensured through local resources.

Application Fees: The application fee for this Project for the interested bidders is Rs 50000/-

The deployment of all the vehicles above would be monitored centrally by the District Administration with the help of GPS tracking.

The interested agencies/ NGOs should submit two sealed envelopes for the (i), (ii), (iii) and (v) Projects for Technical and Financial Proposals and three sealed envelopes for Project (iv) above, clearly mentioning-Technical bid, financial bid for model 1 and financial bid for model 2.

Financial bids should clearly include all the component costs like vehicles (Along with Brand and Make), Medical Equipments provided (Specifications, Brand and Make), Cost of Total Manpower and cost of POL etc.

The date of submission of bids is on 24th November from 11 am to 2 pm for Projects (i) to (vi) above and 30th November from 11 am to 2 pm for Projects (vii). The agencies/ NGOs present will make 10 minutes technical presentations at 3 pm on the same day, to show the features of the monitoring process, their MDU/ MPU capabilities, the capabilities of the proposed Medical Staff and support staff, efficiency of the solution proposed and past experience of the organization in similar programmes elsewhere.

These details should also be incorporated in the technical proposals submitted for evaluation. Experience of delivering Health/ Education related programme in the local Geography/ circumstances will be desired.

The technical bid will be opened the same day in front of all present, to validate the contents of the bid with the presentation made. Based on the assessment of the Technical Bid, the date of Financial Bid opening will be communicated to all the agencies, including the list of technically qualified firms as per the evaluation. Financial bids of only the technically qualified agencies/ NGOs will be opened.
